CHANGEOVER | **PURLEY CROSS**

Towards Whyteleafe South on Purley Road at **BUS STOP M** (Purley Station).

Towards Waddon Marsh on Purley Road at **BUS STOP P** (Purley Station).

Always communicate in advance with iBus if you are late for any reason.

NO MORE THAN 5 MINS LATE IF POSSIBLE



-2:00

NO MORE THAN 2 MINS EARLY AT ANYTIME

Route 439 is a low frequency route. In terms of our performance, it is very important that you are no more than 2 minutes early at any time and when possible, no more than 5 minutes late.

IMPORTANT: Please do your utmost to keep your bus within this 7 minute window unless prevented by traffic or other circumstances beyond your control. A few seconds make a big difference to our performance.

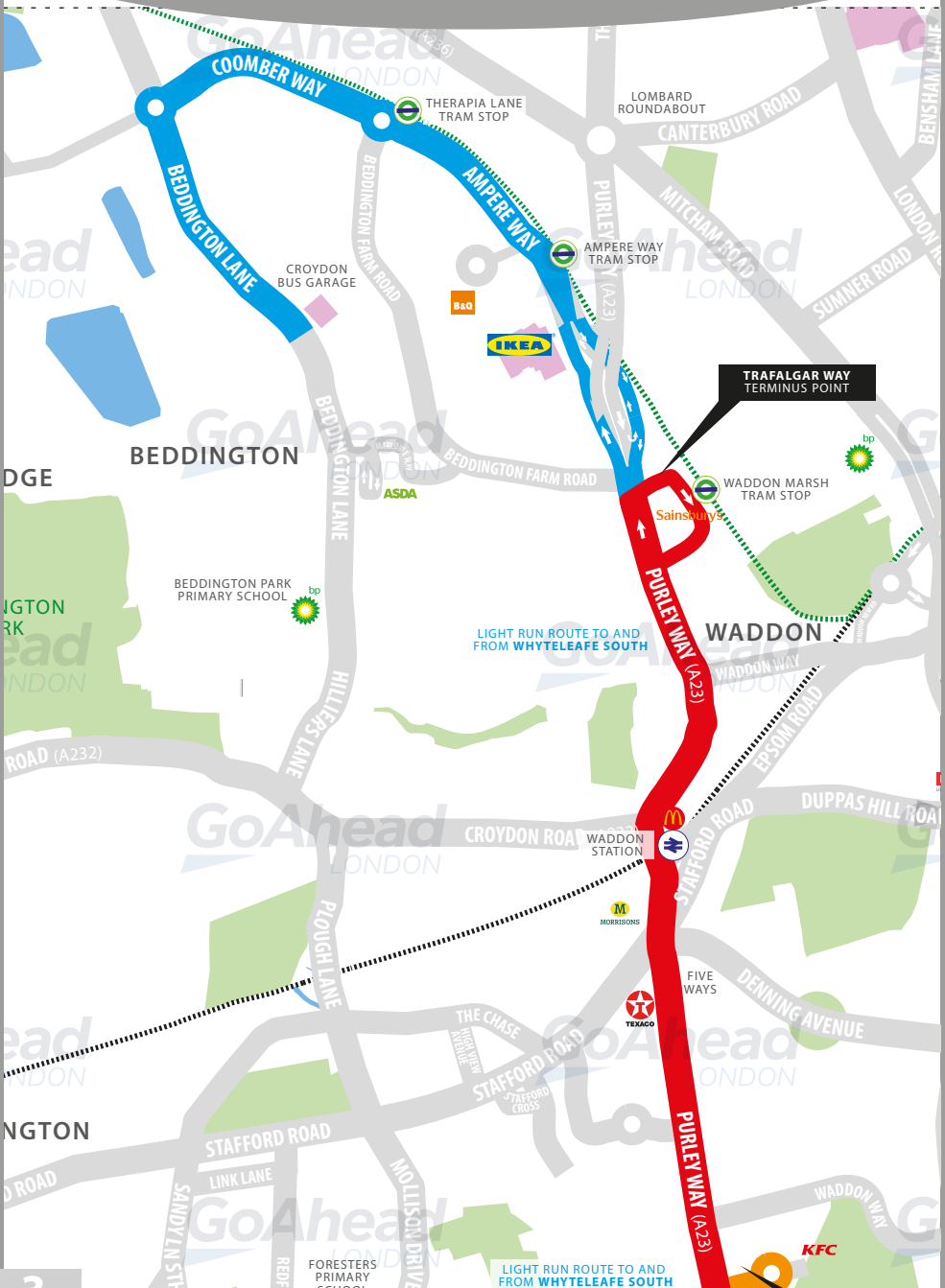

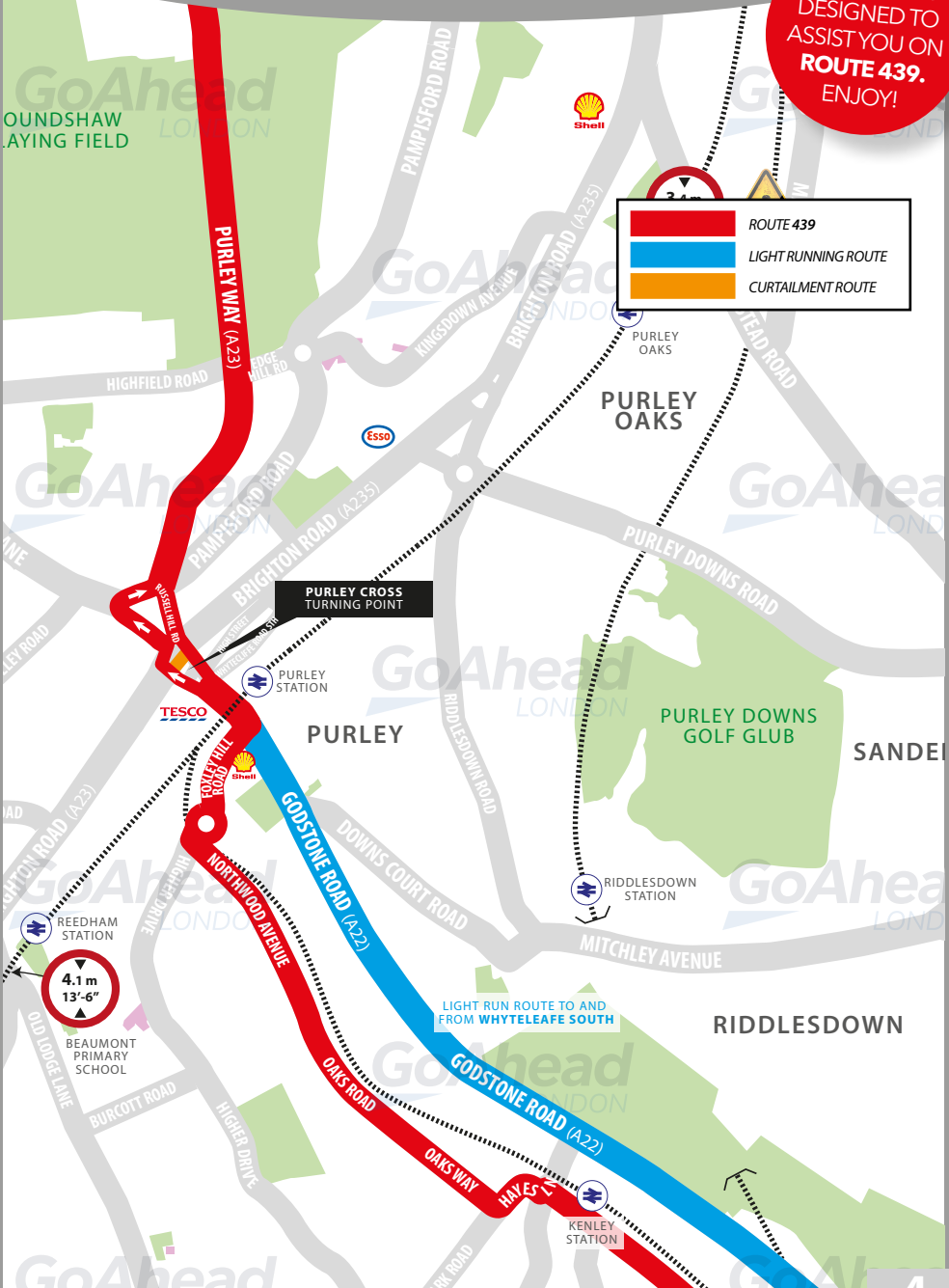

TO WHYTELEAFE SOUTH WAPSES LODGE

- From **Croydon Garage**, turn right onto Beddington Lane **B272**
- At roundabout, take 2nd exit onto Coomber Way
- At roundabout, take 1st exit onto Ampere Way
- At 2nd roundabout, take 1st exit onto Ampere Way
- Keep right and exit onto slip road to Purley Way (*southbound*)
- Continue ahead on Purley Way **A23**
- At traffic light, continue ahead onto Purley Way (*Five Ways*) **A23**
- At traffic light, continue ahead onto Russell Hill Road **A23**
- At traffic light, continue ahead onto Brighton Road **A23**
- Keep left on A22 lane and continue ahead onto Purley Road **A23**
- Continue ahead onto Godstone Road **A22**
- At roundabout, take 2nd exit onto Godstone Road **A22**
- Continue ahead on Godstone Road to Wapses Lodge to **stand**

FROM WHYTELEAFE SOUTH WAPSES LODGE

- At **stand**, continue ahead on Godstone Road **A22**
- At Wapses Lodge Roundabout, take 6th exit back onto Godstone Road **A22**
- Continue ahead on Godstone Road **A22**
- At roundabout, take 2nd exit onto Godstone Road **A22**
- Continue ahead onto Purley Road and keep right **A22**
- On one-way system, turn right onto Brighton Road **A23**
- At traffic light, turn left onto Banstead Road **A23**
- Keep right and at traffic light, turn right onto Foxley Lane **A23**
- Keep left and turn left onto Purley Way **A23**
- At traffic light, continue ahead onto Purley Way (*Five Ways*) **A23**
- Keep left and take the slip road towards Ampere Way (*southbound*)
- At elongated roundabout take 2nd exit onto Ampere Way
- At roundabout, take 2nd exit onto Coomber Way
- At roundabout, take 1st exit onto Coomber Way
- At roundabout, take 1st exit onto Beddington Lane **B272**
- Turn left to **Croydon Garage**

- Keep right and exit onto slip road to Purley Way (*southbound*)
- At traffic light, turn left onto Trafalgar Way (*one-way system*) to **stand**

FROM WADDON MARSH TRAFALGAR WAY

- At **stand**, continue ahead on Trafalgar Way (*one-way system*)
- Follow road right onto Drury Crescent (*one-way system*)
- At traffic light, turn right onto Purley Way **A23**
- Keep left and take the slip road towards Ampere Way (*southbound*)
- At elongated roundabout take 2nd exit onto Ampere Way
- At roundabout, take 2nd exit onto Coomber Way
- At roundabout, take 1st exit onto Coomber Way
- At roundabout, take 1st exit onto Beddington Lane **B272**
- Turn left into **Croydon Garage**

TO WHYTELEAFE SOUTH WAPSES LODGE

- At **stand**, continue ahead on Trafalgar Way (*one-way system*)
- Follow road right onto Drury Crescent (*one-way system*)
- At traffic light, turn left onto Purley Way **A23**
- At traffic light, continue ahead onto Purley Way (*Five Ways*) **A23**
- At traffic light, continue ahead onto Russell Hill Road **A23**
- At traffic light, continue ahead onto Brighton Road **A23**
- Keep left on A22 lane and continue ahead onto Purley Road **A23**
- Continue ahead onto Godstone Road **A22**
- After railway bridge, turn right onto Foxley Hill Road (*Shell petrol station*)
- At roundabout, take 2nd exit onto Higher Drive
- Turn left onto Northwood Avenue
- Continue ahead onto Oaks Road
- Continue ahead onto Oaks Way
- At junction, turn left onto Park Road
- At junction, turn left onto Hayes Lane
- Turn right onto Kenley Lane (*before Kenley Station railway bridge*)
- Continue ahead onto Valley Road
- Continue ahead onto Beverley Road
- Continue ahead onto Hornchurch Hill
- At junction, turn left onto Whyteleafe Hill (*continue over level crossing*)
- At roundabout, take 3rd exit onto Godstone Road
- Continue ahead on Godstone Road to Wapses Lodge to **stand**

- At **stand**, continue ahead on Godstone Road **A22**
- At Wapses Lodge Roundabout, take 6th exit back onto Godstone Road **A22**
- Continue ahead on Godstone Road **A22**
- At roundabout, take 1st exit onto Whyteleafe Hill (*continue over level crossing*)
- Turn right onto Hornchurch Hill
- Continue ahead onto Beverley Road
- Continue ahead onto Valley Road
- Continue ahead onto Kenley Lane
- At junction, turn left onto Hayes Lane (*Kenley Station on right*)
- Turn right onto Park Road
- Turn right onto Oaks Way
- Continue ahead onto Oaks Road
- Continue ahead onto Northwood Avenue
- At junction, turn right onto Higher Drive
- At roundabout, take 2nd exit onto Foxley Hill Road
- At junction, turn left onto Godstone Road **A22** (*Shell petrol station on right*)
- Continue ahead onto Purley Road and keep right **A22**
- On one-way system, turn right onto Brighton Road **A23**

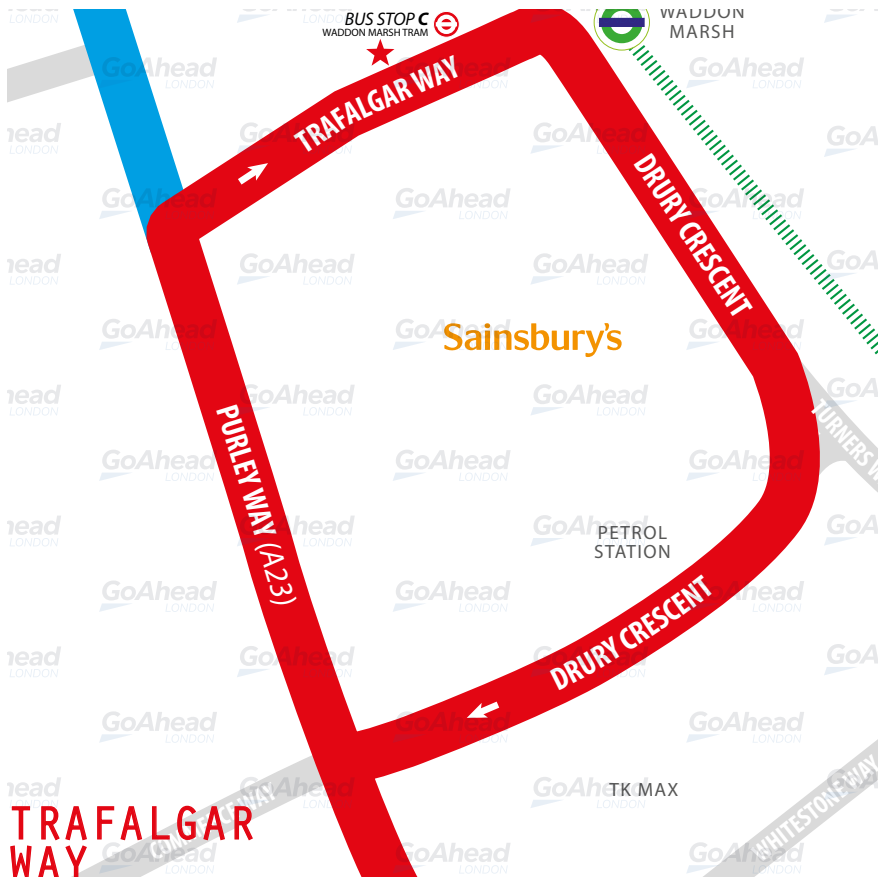

From Whyteleafe South. Proceed from Purley Way, Approach Road To Colonnades Complex to stand. Unscheduled curtailments only. Set down on Purley Way at **BUS STOP BATTLE OF BRITAIN WAR MEMORIAL.**

Towards Whyteleafe South. Depart via Approach Road to Colonnades Complex, Turning Circle, Approach Road to Colonnades Complex to Purley Way. Unscheduled curtailments only. Pick up on Purley Way at **BUS STOP BATTLE OF BRITAIN WAR MEMORIAL.**

Public stand for two buses in lay-by on approach road to Colonnades complex.
Blind display: PURLEY WAY, COLONNADES.

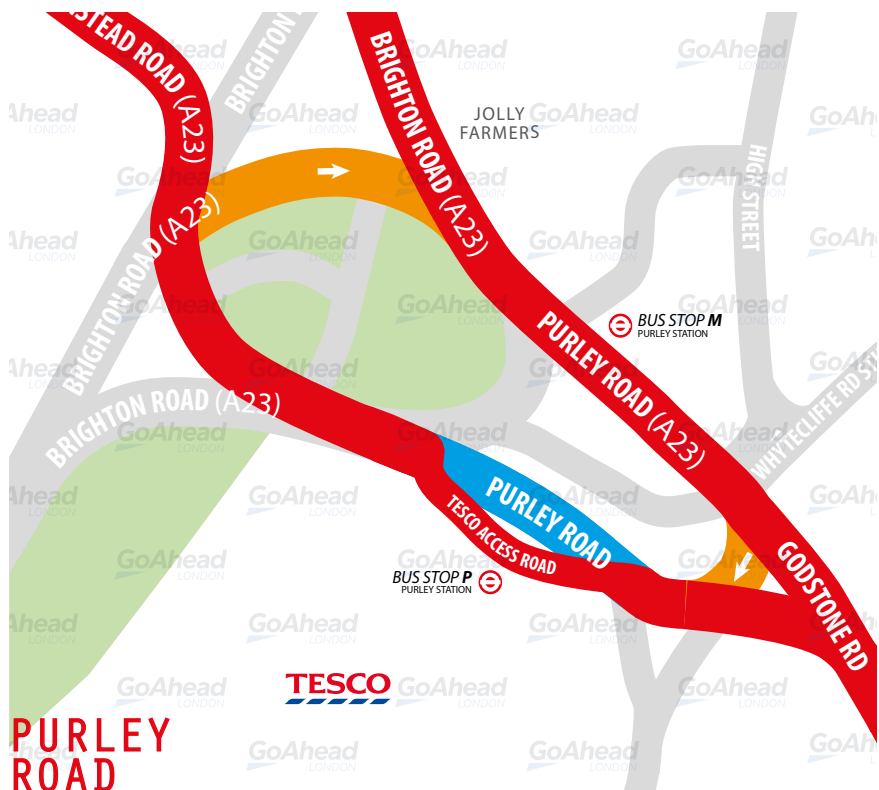

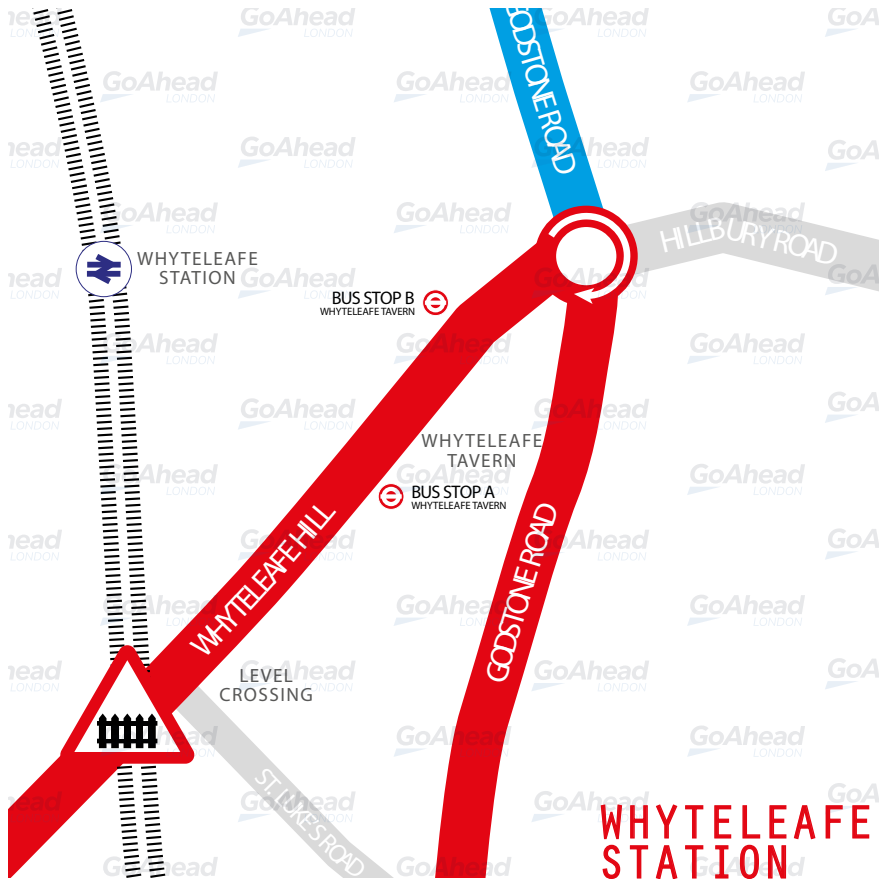

Set down on Godstone Road at **BUS STOP WAPSES LODGE ROUNDABOUT.**

Towards Waddon Marsh. Depart via Godstone Road and Wapses Lodge roundabout to Godstone Road.

Pick up on Godstone Road at **BUS STOP WELL FARM ROAD.**

Public stand for one bus on east side of Godstone Road, between Court Bushes Road and Wapses Lodge Roundabout. **Blind display: WHYTELEAFE SOUTH.**



LOCAL HAZARDS & POINTS TO NOTE

FULL RISK ASSESSMENT VIEWABLE UPON REQUEST



PEDESTRIANS | TRAFALGAR WAY SAINSBURY'S

Heavy pedestrian footfall. Tight right-hand bend after bus stand on Marlowe way. Extreme care and caution, reduce speed.

RISK OF GROUNDING | DRURY CRESCENT

Back of Sainsbury's. Very tight lane. Pedestrian movements walking to tram stop. Care and caution, appropriate speed. Good forward planning.

LANE DISCIPLINE | PURLEY WAY JUNC WADDON ROAD

Heavy traffic. Two lanes merge into one lane. Lanes very tight and traffic fighting for position. Defensive driving, holding back where necessary, good forward planning and mirror use needed.

NARROW LANES | PURLEY WAY JUNC EPSOM ROAD

Heavy traffic with narrow lanes. Extreme care and caution. Good lane discipline needed. Good mirror use important.

MAJOR JUNCTION | PURLEY WAY FIVE WAYS JUNCTION

Major junction with heavy traffic in five directions. Extreme care and caution. Good lane discipline needed.

LANE DISCIPLINE | PURLEY WAY JUNC EDGEHILL ROAD

Two lanes merge into one beyond the junction. Beware fast traffic on the offside lane cutting in. Be prepared to hold back. Good mirror work needed.

NARROW LANES | PURLEY CROSS / RUSSELL HILL ROAD

Heavy traffic, three lanes, narrow lanes. Care and caution. Be prepared to straddle lane. Good mirror work needed.

BUSY PEDESTRIAN AREA | PURLEY TOWN CENTRE

Congested pedestrian area. Drive at appropriate speed and be careful of pedestrians stepping into path of bus.

RAILINGS | PURLEY CROSS TESCO

Railings on both sides of road. Take care when pulling into the bus stop at Tesco as there are railings on both sides.

LOCAL HAZARDS & POINTS TO NOTE

FULL RISK ASSESSMENT VIEWABLE UPON REQUEST



TURN | GODSTONE ROAD JUNC FOXLEY HILL ROAD

Railings close to side of road. Take care when turning right at this junction. Be aware of railings on the pavement and speed humps on road.

TURN | FOXLEY HILL ROAD JUNC GODSTONE ROAD

When driving towards Waddon Marsh, be aware of the sharp left turn when heading into Purley. There are railings on pavement when turning left. Also be aware of vehicles turning onto Foxley Lane. Be prepared to wait for them to proceed before you do.

PARKED VEHICLES | FOXLEY HILL / NORTHWOOD AVENUE

Parked cars close to turning. Be aware of the tree when turning right. 20 mph zone with traffic calming measures. **Important Note. Drivers to stop at the hail and ride section on Higher Road and contact iBus to check for oncoming bus. Drivers to wait for bus to pass before proceeding along Northwood Avenue.** Be aware of the sharp left turn onto Northwood Avenue. Also take extra care as there may be parked cars close to the corner. Take care there is enough road space to proceed. If not, please call Code Blue to CentreComm to inform them the road is blocked. Be aware of pedestrians/vehicles visiting day care centre in busy periods. Also inform iBus Controllers.

PARKED VEHICLES | NORTHWOOD AVENUE

+ Kenley Lane, Valley Road, Beverley Road and Hornchurch Hill. Cars parked on both sides of road. 20 mph zone with traffic calming measures. Ensure there is enough space to pass through the parked cars. If the cars are parked too close, please Code Blue to CentreComm to inform them the road is blocked. Also inform iBus Controllers.

TREES CLOSE TO KERB | VALLEY ROAD

Take care when driving near the kerb as there are trees that are on the edge of the kerb.

TIGHT RIGHT TURN | PARK ROAD TOWARDS PURLEY

Tight right blind turn onto Oaks Way. Extreme care and caution of oncoming bus. **Important Note. Drivers to stop on Park Road and contact iBus to check for oncoming bus. Drivers to wait for oncoming bus to pass before proceeding onto Oaks Way.**

LOCAL HAZARDS & POINTS TO NOTE

FULL RISK ASSESSMENT VIEWABLE UPON REQUEST



VISIBILITY | HORNCHURCH HILL / WHYTELEAFE HILL

Visibility on left turns. Vehicles overtaking stationary traffic to enter car park when railway crossing barrier closed. Take extra care when manoeuvring at this junction. Visibility is limited from the offside due to a bend in the road. Check offside mirrors when moving off as vehicles may be overtaking.

RISK OF GROUNDING | WHYTELEAFE STATION

Level crossing/risk of grounding. Approach level crossing at appropriate speed and ensure your exit from the crossing is clear before you cross over the crossing or enter the yellow box.

LEVEL CROSSING [EMERGENCY] | WHYTELEAFE STATION

In the event of an emergency if vehicle stalls or is grounded on level crossing, immediately get passengers and yourself off the bus and use emergency telephone by level crossing to inform the railway authorities of the emergency situation.

CYCLE LANE | GODSTONE ROAD

Cycle Lanes. Parked vehicles Be aware of cyclists in the cycle lane especially in peak periods. Care and caution when passing parked vehicles.

CYCLE LANE | GODSTONE ROAD

Bus stand. Be aware of cyclists when pulling left onto bus stand.

FACILITIES | THROUGHOUT THE ROUTE

Whyteleafe South, Court Bushes Road. Toilet facilities available.

If you urgently need to use a facility, please inform iBus immediately.

CODE RED | EMERGENCY RADIO PROCEDURE

If you require the Emergency Services to attend your vehicle (for example in the event of passenger injury, assault or major RTA), contact CentreComm using the radio's Code Red facility. To call CentreComm, **hold down the Code Red button on your vehicle's radio for at least 3 seconds** until you hear a ringing tone to indicate that your call has been connected. Hold down the foot switch in the cab when you are speaking, and end what you have to say with the word "over" to indicate that you expect a response. Release the foot switch when you are not speaking. Remember to speak slowly and clearly. You will usually receive a radio call from your depot shortly after you make a Code Red call. **You should not use the radio whilst the vehicle is in motion**
