Route N87 is a low frequency route. In terms of our performance, it is very important that you are no more than 2 minutes early at any time and when possible, no more than 5 minutes late.

IMPORTANT: Please do your utmost to keep your bus within this 7 minute window unless prevented by traffic or other circumstances beyond your control. A few seconds make a big difference to our performance.







Public stand for two buses on west side of Lambton Road. **Blind display:** *RAYNES PARK*.







Private stand for eight buses in 2 portions in slip road off Falcon Road (west side) south of Grant Road. **Blind display: CLAPHAM JUNCTION**.





Private offside stand for 6 buses in three sections (24, 37 and 12 metres) in Bondway. **Blind display:** *VAUXHALL BUS STATION*.





SWITCH THE ENGINE OFF WHILST AT THE STAND

From Kingston. Proceed from Whitehall via Whitehall Place to stand. Set down on Whitehall at ALIGHTING POINT.

Towards Kingston. Depart via Whitehall Place, Northumberland Avenue and Charing Cross to Whitehall. Pick up on Whitehall at BUS STOP N.

Public stand for three buses on north side of Whitehall Place. Blind display: WHITEHALL, HORSE GUARDS.




ALDWYCHTERMINUS POINT

IMPORTANT LOG OFF IBUS IMMEDIATELY IF RUNNING LIGHT

From Kingston. Proceed from Whitehall via Whitehall Place to stand. Set down on Whitehall at *ALIGHTING POINT*.

Towards Kingston. Depart via Whitehall Place, Northumberland Avenue and Charing Cross to Whitehall. Pick up on Whitehall at *BUS STOP N*.

Public stand on north side of Aldwych (east arm). Additional overflow stand on the south side of Strand and Melbourne Place. **Blind display:** ALDWYCH.



FULL RISK ASSESSMENT VIEWABLE UPON REQUEST

ROAD LAYOUT LANCASTER PLACE JUNC ALDWYCH

Road layout from one direction traffic flow to two-way traffic flow opposite direction. Low trees close to kerb on the nearside when pulling into the bus stop. Before leaving setting down bus stop D, make sure all passengers have alighted, position bus in the right lane to proceed to the bus stand.

BUS STAND | STRAND AUSTRALIA HOUSE

3 x bus stand on the left-hand side of the road. Strand is also an access vehicle only road for residents. Watch out for vehicles on the offside as you leave bus stand. Melbourne Place 3 x bus stand on the left. Check offside mirror carefully before attempting to move off from Strand bus stand. Care and caution when exiting Melbourne Place, turning left onto the Strand.

VOLUME OF PEDESTRIANS | STRAND

Large pedestrian movement crossing the road at any points, especially at theatre exit times Be alert for pedestrian movements.

EMERGING TRAFFIC | STRAND JUNC DUCANNON STREET

(Eastbound). Traffic emerging from the left. Ensure good view is taken through first offside window of bus, to know path is clear of approaching traffic.

TAXIS | STRAND CHARING CROSS STATION

(Westbound). Taxis entering station forecourt at speed from both directions. Watch carefully for any short cuts taken by taxis at this point.

VOLUME OF PEDESTRIANS | TRAFALGAR SQUARE

Large roundabout and many junctions. Very high volume of pedestrians in area.

VOLUME OF PEDESTRIANS | WHITEHALL HORSE GUARDS

Very congested with pedestrians, who sometimes walk into the roadway.

Overhanging trees. Slow down at this point. Careful observation of trees during Summer and Autumn seasons, when rain occurs.

BUSY PEDESTRIAN AREA | PARLIAMENT SQUARE

Very congested with motorists and pedestrians on all corners and junctions of Square. Check mirrors on all corners for motorist activity, especially cutting up. Watch for pedestrians crossing to the centre of the Square.

FULL RISK ASSESSMENT VIEWABLE UPON REQUEST

BUSY PEDESTRIAN AREA | ST. MARGARET STREET

Often busy with pedestrians queuing to gain access to the Houses of Parliament. Keep a sharp eye for heavy pedestrian movement.

LOW TREES | MILLBANK

Between Houses of Parliament and Vauxhall Bridge. Overhanging trees especially when wet. Position bus away from the kerb to avoid contact.

BUSY ROUNDABOUT | LAMBETH BRIDGE ROUNDABOUT

Busy roundabout with some fast moving traffic from all access roads. Make sure you check carefully to the right before pulling out.

TRAFFIC | VAUXHALL BRIDGE NORTHBOUND

Fast moving traffic coming up from nearside (Wandsworth Road) to join bridge. Be prepared to give way to traffic from the nearside.

VARIOUS HAZARDS | VAUXHALL BUS STATION

Entering the bus station towards Aldwych, look out for buses on the offside entering the coming through. Entering the bus station towards Wandsworth, you must give way to buses entering from your right. Leaving the bus station towards Aldwych, check that South Lambeth Place is clear in both directions before pulling out and then position your bus in centre lane to proceed across main junction with Wandsworth Road to reach Vauxhall Bridge. Leaving the Bus Station towards Wandsworth, wait for the traffic control signals before moving out into Parry Street. Check views at all junctions before proceeding. Adjust speed accordingly. Heavy pedestrian area, be alert at all times for people crossing the roads, especially to reach the tube station.

LANE DISCIPLINE | WANDSWORTH RD JUNC NINE ELMS LN

Moving from nearside bus lane across into offside bus lane for Vauxhall Bus Station. Wait for the traffic control signal to give access to move safely over to offside lane.

QUEUING TRAFFIC | WANDSWORTH ROAD

Sainsbury's (Eastbound). Traffic queuing in nearside lane to gain entry to car park at busy times. Check offside mirror and give clear signal to indicate you are moving bus out into centre of road to pass queue.

FULL RISK ASSESSMENT VIEWABLE UPON REQUEST



Between Nine Elms lane and Lansdowne Way. Westbound cycle lane. Watch for cyclists using lane. Very busy at peak times.

PARKED VEHICLES | LANSDOWNE WAY

South Thames College and small shopping area with many parked vehicles. Look for pedestrians trying to cross the road from behind parked vehicles.

BUS LANE | WANDSWORTH ROAD JUNC UNION ROAD

Short section of bus lane eastbound. Take care when leaving bus lane to rejoin Wandsworth Road, as cars will attempt to push in.

VARIOUS HAZARDS | WANDSWORTH ROAD STATION

Trees sited close to kerb. Keep bus out form kerb by at least 18 inches to allowance clearance. 20 mph. Many pedestrians in area at peak times. Watch for pedestrians who try crossing the road at any point in the vicinity of the station.

NIGHTCLUBS | WANDSWORTH ROAD JUNC NORTH STREET

2 night clubs – Lost Society and Artesian Wells well patronised in the evening. Pedestrians on pavement areas. Keep an eye for pedestrians who can be under the influence straying onto the roadway. Be prepared to brake sharply.

LANE DISCIPLINE | BRAYBURNE AVE AND CEDARS ROAD

Wandsworth Road. Motorists traversing the offside bus lane line, and cyclists in bus lane. Watch out for traffic on right hand side as you progress along bus lane. Many cyclists in peak period using bus lane.

BUSY JUNCTION | CEDARS RD AND QUEENSTOWN ROAD

A large number of vehicles making right hand turns at this busy junction. Sainsbury's lorries often unloading near junction. Watch for oncoming traffic. Good use of mirrors needed here.

ROAD ISLANDS | LAVENDER HILL

From Cedars Road to Falcon Road. Various platforms and centre road islands to negotiate. Slow down and take care as you drive over the platforms. Keep speed down when passing islands.

FULL RISK ASSESSMENT VIEWABLE UPON REQUEST

LANE DISCIPLINE | LAVENDER HILL

Junction with Elspeth Road and Latchmere Road. Road narrows from 2 lanes to 1 lane in a westbound direction, be aware of cycle lane on the n/s as you cross the junction. Good use of mirrors needed, as motorists in the right turn lane forcing their way in front to continue ahead.

LANE DISCIPLINE | LAVENDER HILL JUNC FALCON ROAD

Westbound traffic queuing to make right hand turn into Falcon Road. On the eastbound approach into Lavender Hill, the road reduces from 2 lanes to 1 lane. Make good use of offside mirror to check gap between stationary traffic and bus. Look ahead also for motorists parked too far over the line. Keep an eye on motorists attempting to cut in at junctions.

VARIOUS HAZARDS | ST. JOHN'S HILL

Traffic parked on both sides of road during busy periods and on evenings and Sundays. Heavy movement of pedestrians in the area at peak times. Watch out for pedestrians moving out from behind parked vehicles. Watch for taxi passengers getting out into the middle of the roadway.

RIGHT TURN TRAFFIC | ST. JOHN'S HILL

Plough Road and Strath Terrace. Traffic in right lane cutting in front. Beware of traffic in right turn lane only cutting in front to continue ahead. Check mirrors and give when necessary.

FAST TRAFFIC | ST. JOHN'S HILL JUNC MARCILLY RD

Huguenot Place, junction with East Hill. Fast moving traffic approaching form the right. Fast moving westbound traffic entering East Hill on nearside of bus. Look for fast moving approaching traffic from the right before pulling into Marcilly Road and again from the left when entering East Hill. Check nearside mirrors when moving off.

LANE DISCIPLINE | FAIRFIELD STREET JUNC EAST HILL

Lane to turn left into East Hill reduces to 1 lane and has a sharp left hand turn Make good us of mirrors before reaching corner and lights, and watch for cars that try to push in/over.

FULL RISK ASSESSMENT VIEWABLE UPON REQUEST

LANE DISCIPLINE | WANDSWORTH HIGH STREET

Opposite Town Hall. Moving from kerbside into 3rd lane offside. When traversing High Street, heavy traffic on nearside. Check mirrors and physically loom to the right as well to see traffic emerging form one way system into High Street, then pull over with care and monitor movements of traffic on nearside.

LANE DISCIPLINE | ARMOURY WAY

Pulling out of The Plain into Armoury Way. General traffic changing lanes at speed. Make sure offside mirror is fully checked before pulling off. Wait for green traffic light signal. Once in middle lane of Armoury Way lane, check mirrors on both sides as you move along. There will be fast traffic passing the bus on both sides to the junction with Fairfield Street.

VARIOUS HAZARDS | HIGH STREET JUNC BUCKHOLD RD

Sharp left hand turn from High Street into Buckhold Road, with traffic lights and pedestrian crossing right on the corner. Watch for pedestrians who try to cross at wrong times, and do not pass too close to nearside, as railings are present.

PARKED VEHICLES | MERTON RD JUNC BROOKWOOD RD

Parked vehicles at night along both sides of the full length of the road. Slow bus down to cross humps to avoid damage to bus and discomfort to passengers. Watch out for pedestrian movement from parked cars.

MOSQUE | MERTON ROAD

Mosque with evening services creating a large amount of pedestrian movement and car parking. Keep a sharp eye and also poor standards of car parking, making road narrow and difficulty in passing other large vehicles.

ROAD NARROWS | DURNSFORD ROAD BRIDGE

Road narrows to cross bridge, with rumble trips. Slow down for rumble strips, and travel across bridge at a slow speed to enable 'S' bend to be take safely.

VARIOUS HAZARDS | GAP ROAD

Parked cars along whole length of road on both sides, making road narrow to pass large vehicles. Sets of speed humps and a humped Zebra crossing at junction with Ashcombe Road. Dairy exit just prior to railway bridge crossing west of Ashcombe Road. Watch for pedestrian movements.

FULL RISK ASSESSMENT VIEWABLE UPON REQUEST

VARIOUS HAZARDS | ALEXANDRA ROAD

Immediate pedestrian crossing on entry to Alexandra Road. Low trees sighted to very close to kerb. Several sets of traffic calming measures in place. Be prepared to stop when turning left from Gap Road to Alexandra Road. Position bus away form kerb edge to avoid damage to bodywork from trees. Slow down for traffic calming measures, which can be tight to negotiate in an easterly direction. 20 mph.

VARIOUS HAZARDS | THE BROADWAY NEXT TO STATION

Several sets of pedestrian lights with heavy pedestrian presence. Sharp left hand turn travelling north from Hartfield Road into Broadway, with pedestrian lights right on the corner. Watch for last minute runners. Very busy pedestrian movement across this junction to an from station or shopping centre area.

LANE DISCIPLINE BROADWAY JUNC GLADSTONE ROAD

(Southbound). 3 lanes of traffic reduce to 2 and a 20 mph limit applies in Town Centre area. Humped pedestrian crossing. Check mirrors for traffic on both sides prior to reaching reduced road width and give way as necessary. Reduce speed to observe limit, and cross humped pedestrian.

TRAFFIC LIGHTS | WIMBLEDON BUS STATION

Access from Bus Station into Sir Cyril Black Way. Access is controlled by traffic lights. Do not emerge until the green light is showing, otherwise a collision could occur with motorists from the nearside.

LANE DISCIPLINE | HARTFIELD ROAD

3 lanes reduce to 2 forward lanes. Take the centre lane in Hartfield Road, otherwise you end up in a cul-de-sac.

SHARP TURN | WIMBLEDON HILL JUNC WORPLE ROAD

Very sharp left hand turn with traffic lights, bollards and railings to contend with Take turn slowly to avoid collision with street furniture or pedestrians

BELL ON CORNER | WORPLE ROAD JUNC PEPYS ROAD

(Westbound). Pedestrian crossing on bend at junction. Bell on the corner. Slow down near junction and be prepared to stop if necessary.

FULL RISK ASSESSMENT VIEWABLE UPON REQUEST

PEDESTRIAN CROSSING COOMBE LANE

Humped pedestrian crossing with lights and outside Co-op store. Parked vehicles on both side of road at night near pub. Slow down to cross humped crossing to avoid damage to bus and discomfort to passengers. Watch for busy pedestrian activity in vicinity.

MINI ROUNDABOUT | WEST BARNES LN JUNC COOMBE LA

Mini roundabout with dip in road northbound. Very tight left hand turn into West Barnes Lane (westbound). Handle junction slowly in both directions.

HAZARD | WEST BARNES LANE JUNC BODNANT GDNS

Small mini roundabout with traffic calming measures. Cross the roundabout slowly and with care to avoid street furniture on built out areas.

CROSSING | WEST BARNES LANE JUNC BURLINGTON RD

Busy build up of traffic queues for level crossing and exit from Tesco car park. Be prepared for queue to get through, and watch for pedestrian movements.

PARKED VEHICLES | BURLINGTON ROAD

Between West Barnes Lane and Shannon Corner. Parked vehicles both sides of the road at night. Look for pedestrians emerging from behind parked vehicles.

PARKED VEHICLES | BURLINGTON ROAD

Between Shannon Corner and New Malden 'The Fountain'. Speed humps and tables. Parked vehicles both sides of the road at night. Negotiate road humps and table crossings slowly and with care to avoid damage to bus and discomfort to passengers.

CYCLISTS KINGSTON ROAD

Many pedestrian crossings. Cycle lane traversed pass in front of the bus stop Be very observant along the full length of this road for pedestrians crossing at any point and cyclists, care and caution at stops.

LOW TREES | KINGSTON ROAD

Road narrows going westbound near junction with Hampden Road from 2 lanes to 1 lane. Keep bus out from kerb area to avoid collision with trees. Where road narrows down, be observant for motorists who attempt to cut in front.

CODE RED EMERGENCY RADIO PROCEDURE

If you require the Emergency Services to attend your vehicle (for example in the event of passenger injury, assault or major RTA), you should contact CentreComm using the radio's Code Red facility. To call CentreComm, hold down the Code Red button on your vehicle's radio for at least 3 seconds until you see *** displayed on the MDT screen to indicate that your call has been connected. Hold down the foot switch in the cab when you are speaking, and end what you have to say with the word "over" to indicate that you expect a response. Release the foot switch when you are not speaking. Remember to speak slowly and clearly. Note that you will usually receive a radio call from your depot shortly after you make a Code Red call. You should not use the radio whilst the vehicle is in motion.
