Proposed Changes:

At this time, no changes are proposed to the existing service for introduction prior to the commencement of the new Route Agreement for Route No. 106.

Tenderers should note that the following alterations (subject to consultation) are proposed as part of this Service Specification for introduction with the new Route Agreement:

- The additional Mondays to Fridays AM peak flow journey ex Finsbury Park Station, Station Place Stop H is withdrawn.
- Mondays to Saturdays daytime frequencies are reduced from every 7-8 minutes (8 buses per hour) to every 8 minutes.

4) OPERATIONAL CONSIDERATIONS

- 4.1) Route No. 106 should be separated from Route Nos. 254 & N253 between Clapton, Kenninghall Road/Thistlewaite Road and Bethnal Green Station during all periods, where possible.
- 4.2) When compiling schedules Tenderers are asked to consider passengers making connections to other services at the following locations: Finsbury Park LU and rail station, Stoke Newington rail station, Clapton rail station, Hackney Central rail station, Cambridge Heath rail station and Bethnal Green LU station.
- 4.3) Under no circumstances must double deck buses be taken along Stroud Green Road south of the junction with Morris Place due to a low railway bridge. Buses must not turn left from Station Place.
- 4.4) Route No. 106 suffers from unpredictable traffic delays in the Finsbury Park, Stoke Newington, Hackney and Bethnal Green areas.
- 4.5) Football matches at Emirates Stadium can also cause traffic congestion in the Finsbury Park area.
- 4.6) Crossrail will connect the City, Canary Wharf, the West End and Heathrow Airport to commuter areas east and west of the capital. Major construction of the railway began in 2010, with services expected to commence in 2018. The construction impacts of Crossrail could affect Route No. 106 and it is anticipated that some passenger demand for Route No. 106 may shift to this line when it opens. Route No. 106 will be reviewed closer to the opening date.
