### **Proposed Changes:**

- Ex Canning Town Bus Station, 1 peak flow journey is specified during the Mondays to Fridays PM peak to provide a frequency of every 5 minutes to arrive at East Ham Town Hall between 1715 and 1730.
- Tenderers should refer to the schedules dated 01/04/2013 rather than the current emergency schedules

Tenderers are also encouraged to offer two axle vehicles with a longer wheelbase and increased capacity, subject to route constraints. Tenders offering such vehicles will be welcomed and carefully considered by the Corporation. Triaxle vehicles are not being considered by the Corporation at this time.

## 4) OPERATIONAL CONSIDERATIONS

- 4.1) Route No. 147 can suffer from unpredictable traffic delays in the Barking Road, Canning Town Flyover area.
- 4.2) Football matches at West Ham United F.C. in Upton Park can cause traffic congestion in the area (Barking Road).
- 4.3) The use of vehicles longer than 10.5 metre is not possible in Little Ilford due to highway constraints.
- 4.4) Crossrail will connect the City, Canary Wharf, the West End and Heathrow Airport to commuter areas east and west of the capital. Major construction of the railway began in 2010, with services expected to commence in 2018. The construction impacts of Crossrail could affect Route No. 147 and it is anticipated that some passenger demand for Route No. 147 may shift to this line when it opens. Route No. 147 will be reviewed closer to the opening date.
