1) NOTES

Proposed Changes:

At this time, no changes are proposed to the existing service for introduction prior to the commencement of the new Route Agreement for Route No. 308.

Tenderers should note that there are no changes proposed as part of this Service Specification for Route No. 308. However, since 16th July 2007, Route No. 308 has been on a long term temporary diversion due to Olympic construction works. The routeing via Olympic Park will commence when the works are completed. Therefore, Tenderers should submit the two options which are as follows:

Option 1: (For introduction prior to the completion of the Olympic Park works)

- Route No. 308 will continue to operate via the long term temporary diversion in the Leyton area. Ex Wanstead, Woodbine Place, buses are diverted from Leyton Road via Temple Mill Lane, Leyton High Road, Alexandra Road and York Road to Ruckholt Road to re-join normal line of routeing. Ex Clapton Park, Millfields Road, buses are diverted from Ruckholt Road via Leyton High Road and Temple Mill Lane to Leyton Road to re-join normal line of routeing. **Please see Section 5 for a full list of streets traversed.**

Option 2: (For expected introduction during May 2013 when the roads become available in Olympic Park)

- Route No. 308 is re-routed via Olympic Park.
- Ex Wanstead, Woodbine Place, Route No. 308 is re-routed from Stratford Broadway via Stratford High Street, Warton Road, road within Stratford City Development, First Avenue, North Loop Road, North Avenue, Clays Lane, Temple Mill Lane, A12, Eastway and Waterden Road to Homerton Road to re-join normal line of routeing. Ex Clapton Park, Millfields Road, Route No. 308 is re-routed from Ruckholt Road via Temple Mill Lane, Clays Lane, North Avenue, North Loop Road, First Avenue, road within Stratford City Development, Warton Road and Stratford High Street to Great Eastern Road to re-join normal line of routeing. **Please see Section 5 for a full list of streets traversed.**
- Mondays to Saturdays frequencies are increased from every 15 minutes to every 12 minutes.
- Sundays and all evenings frequencies are increased from every 30 minutes to every 20 minutes.

Options 1 & 2:

- 60 capacity, dual door, single deck vehicles are specified (55 capacity, dual door, single deck vehicles are acceptable), subject to a satisfactory route test.

4) OPERATIONAL CONSIDERATIONS

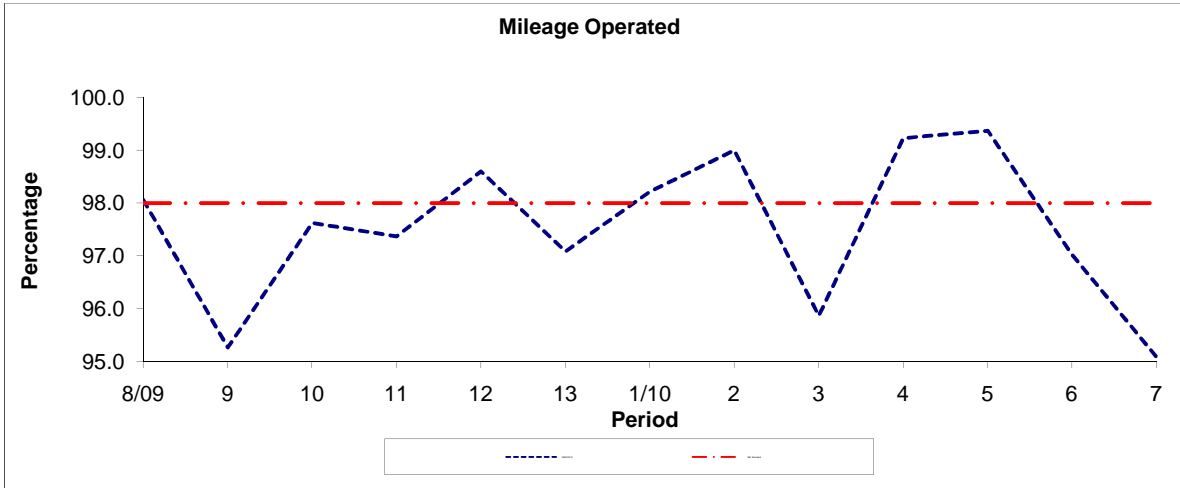
- 4.1) Route No. 308 can suffer from unpredictable traffic delays in the Stratford area, particularly during peak periods.
- 4.2) Crossrail will connect the City, Canary Wharf, the West End and Heathrow Airport to commuter areas east and west of the capital. Major construction of the railway began this year, with services expected to commence in 2018. The construction impacts of Crossrail at Forest Gate, Maryland and Stratford could affect Route No. 308 and it is anticipated that some passenger demand for Route No. 308 would shift to this line when it opens. Route No. 308 will be reviewed closer to the opening date. Expected changes in demand as a result of Crossrail will be reviewed separately.
- 4.3) The Olympic Park is located within an area bounded by Stratford High Street, the River Lee Navigation, Ruckholt Road and Leyton Road. The site is adjacent to and part overlaps the Stratford City Development (SCD). Construction of facilities for the 2012 Games has commenced.
- 4.4) Immediately following 2012, a number of buildings will be converted for legacy uses. The Olympic Village will become housing, the Press Centre converted for other employment uses and some venues retained for public use.
- 4.5) Beyond this, further significant development is expected in the Olympic Park site after 2014. This will be more clearly defined through a Legacy Masterplan due to be worked up in detail in 2010.
- 4.6) The 2012 Olympic Games open on Friday 27th July and close on Sunday 12th August. The 2012 Paralympic Games start on Wednesday 29th August and close on Sunday 9th September. The Games will result in additional passenger demand across the network, requiring additional capacity on some routes. There will also be a number of road closures in the event areas resulting in route diversions. Operators should be aware there will be implications to them during this time. Full details and any extra resource required will be negotiated with the operator at a later date.
