- Route No. 483 will operate via the existing routeing of Route Nos. 83 & N83, Route No. 245 and Route No.182 between Ealing Hospital Grounds, Stop U and Wembley Stadium Station, East Lane and between Watford Road and Harrow, Bus Station respectively.

4) OPERATIONAL CONSIDERATIONS

- 4.1) Route No. 483 should interwork with Route No. N83 to provide a seamless 24 hour service between Ealing Hospital Grounds, Stop U and Wembley Stadium Station.
- 4.2) Route No. 483 should interwork with Route No. 182 between Harrow, Bus Station and Watford Road (at junction with East Lane) during all periods.
- 4.3) Route No. 483 may suffer from unpredictable traffic delays in the Alperton and Wembley areas.
- 4.4) Route No. 83 may suffer from delays caused by traffic congestion along A406 Hanger Lane approaching the gyratory mainly during the Mondays to Fridays PM peak.
- 4.5) Route Nos. 483 may sometimes suffer from unpredictable and severe delays caused by sports and other events at the Wembley complex.
- 4.6) There isn't an available stand at Harrow town centre but it is envisaged that one can be made available either through a short extension of another shorter route standing at the bus station or a new stand on College Road or Kymberley Road. Plans to redevelop the existing bus station may also allow additional standing. Further work will be undertaken to find an appropriate stand in liaison with the London Borough of Harrow. Tenderers should assume that a suitable stand will be made available within 5 minutes running time (in each direction) of Harrow, Bus Station.

4) OPERATIONAL CONSIDERATIONS - continued

- 4.7) It is expected that some passenger demand will shift from Ealing Hospital to Northwick Park Hospital. This may affect demand on the route.
- 4.8) Crossrail will connect the City, Canary Wharf, the West End and Heathrow Airport to commuter areas east and west of the capital. Major construction of the railway began in 2010, with the first services expected to commence through the central London tunnelled section in late 2018. The full Crossrail service will be operating from Heathrow and Reading to Abbey Wood and Shenfield in late 2019. The construction impacts of Crossrail could affect Route No. 483 and it is anticipated that some passenger demand for Route No. 483 may shift to this line when it opens. Route No. 483 will be reviewed closer to the opening date.
