

Freedom Passes or Travel Permits

London Boroughs Elderly, Disabled and Blind Persons *freedom pass*. Elderly and Disabled Persons *freedom pass* - valid throughout for free travel, except between 0430 and 0859 Mondays to Fridays. Valid all day public holidays. Blind Persons *freedom pass* - valid throughout for free travel at any time. No other freedom passes are accepted on LT services.

Surrey Elderly and Disabled Persons Travel Permits ♦ Whenever valid, the child rate (*Concessionary Single fare*). Valid throughout these routes, except between 0430 and 0859 Mondays to Fridays. Valid all day public holidays. **Holders of Disabled persons permits - any time.**

♦ **Surrey Permits also entitle a companion to concessionary single fare where indicated.**

Surrey Student Farecards & Education Tickets

Surrey Student Farecards: Valid for travel at child fare, at anytime, provided the journey starts and/or finishes between **Hampton Court, Creek Road 16** and **West Molesey Central Square 20**; irrespective of the points listed or operator named on the ticket.

Surrey Education Free Season Tickets: Valid Monday to Friday Schooldays only, between the points shown on the ticket.

London United Scholars Term Passes are **not** accepted on this service.

London United "555 Faresaver" Passes are **not** accepted on this service.

The following are also available between stages **16 & 20**:

Four zones	1234	Three or more zones all tickets <u>except</u> 123

A Penalty Fare of £5 is payable if you fail to show on demand a valid ticket or pass for the whole of your journey on this bus.

16-17 & (London Transport) Student Photocard holders are charged the adult fare at *all* times.

Surrey Sunday Rider

Tickets may be issued and accepted on Route **411** on Sundays and public holidays, for travel throughout the route.

Adult	£5.25
Child/OAP	£3.85
Family (2 Adults & 2 Children)	£10.50

Hampshire Sunday Rovers may also be accepted for travel throughout the route.

Wheelchair-users are permitted to travel **free**, throughout this route - at any time, on all journeys operated by wheelchair accessible vehicles.

Child & New Deal Fares

Up to two children under 5 years accompanying an adult or child ticket or pass holder and not occupying seats to the exclusion of other passengers are carried free.

Children aged 5 and under 14 years and additional children under 5 years, children aged 14 and 15 years producing a valid Child Rate Photocard, also holders of a valid New Deal Photocard; are charged the fares below for a single journey on one bus.

All times (except as below) **40p**

From 2200 to 0429 daily **Adult fare**

Within box and below bold lines

Half adult fare except:

From 2200 to 0429 daily Fares within box **70p**

Children of 14 and 15 years not producing a valid Child Rate Photocard, also New Deal participants not producing a valid New Deal Photocard, are charged the adult fare at all times.

The fares shown apply only when through journeys are run
